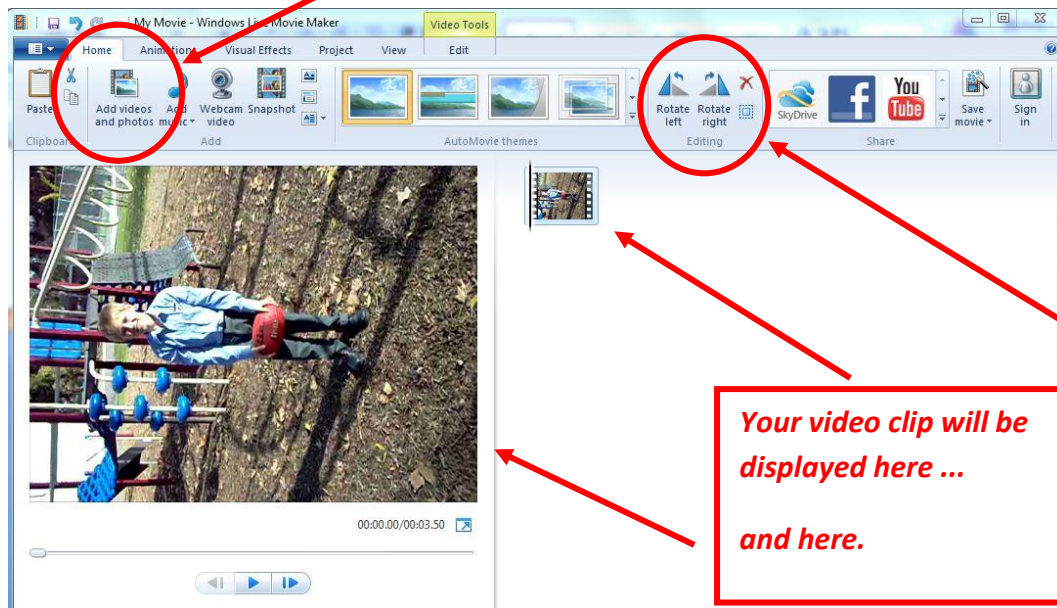
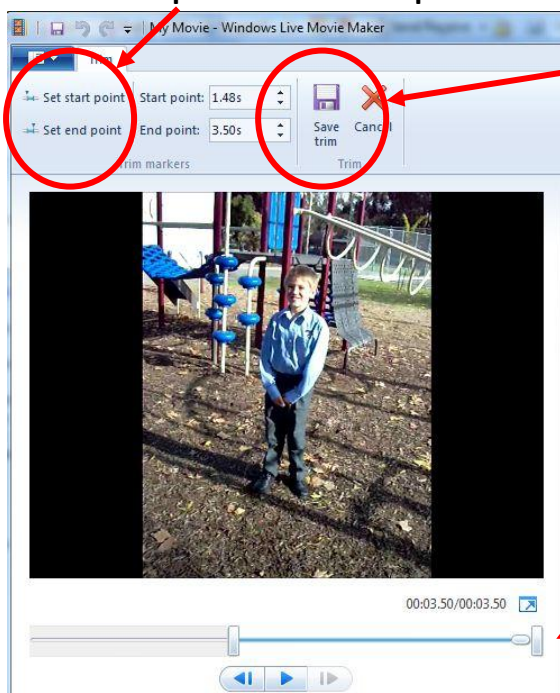


3KM/3E - UOI – Force Movie Making Steps

1. Save your video clip to your **USB drive**.
2. Select the **Windows Live Movie Maker** program from the **Start** menu.
3. Go to the **Home** menu and select **Add videos and photos**.
Select your video clip on your USB drive and then click **Open**.



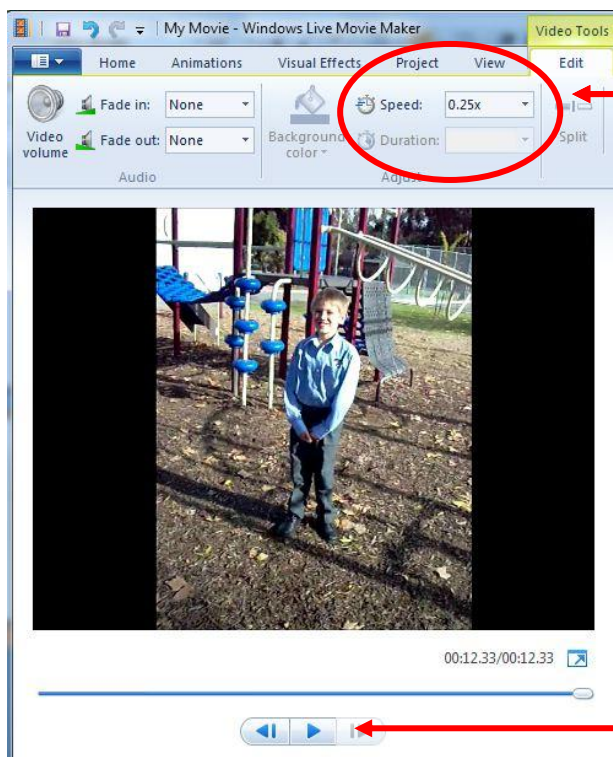
4. If your video clip was taken sideways (oops 😊) then rotate it by clicking **Rotate left** or **Rotate right**.
5. Go to the **Video Tools Edit** menu and select **Trim Tool**.
Set the **start point** and the **end point** of the video clip and then press **Save trim**.



6. **Save** your hard work so far on your USB stick. Give your project a name that you will remember.



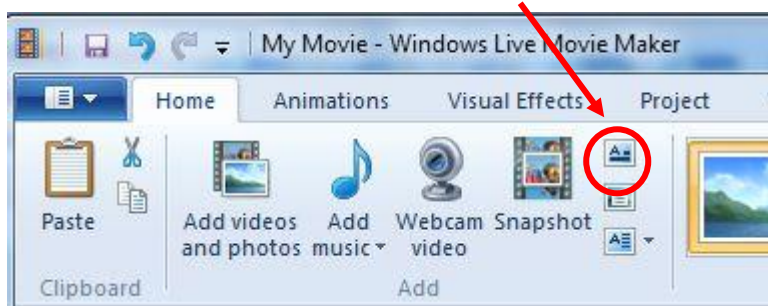
7. Go to the **Video Tools Edit** menu and select the speed of your video clip from the **Speed** tool.



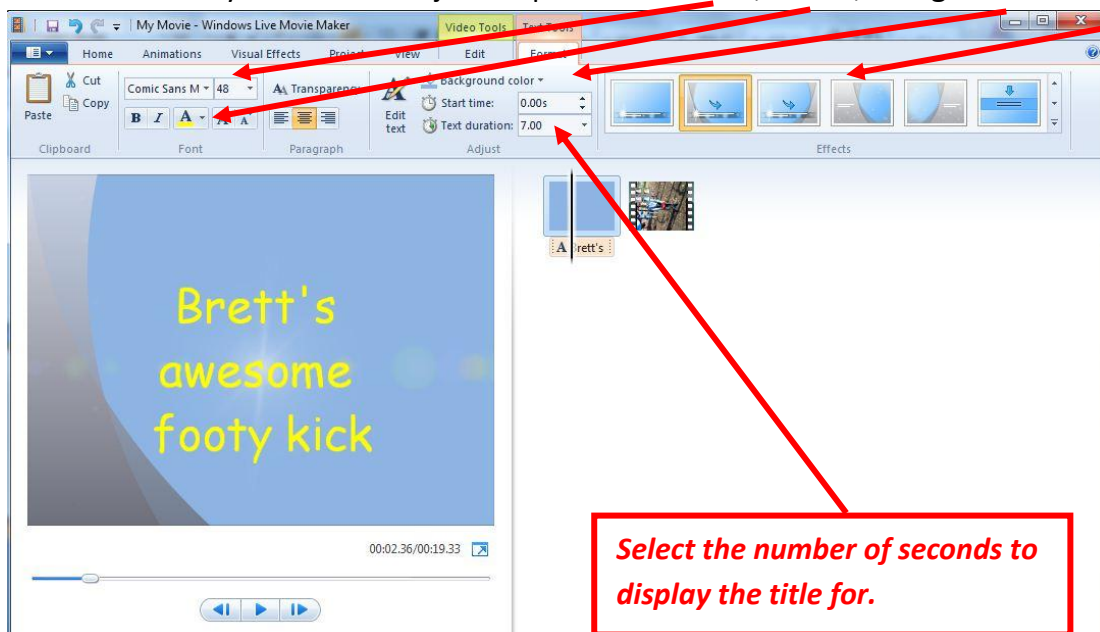
*1x is normal speed.
0.5x is slow motion.
0.25x is very slow motion.
0.125x is very, very slow motion.*

Press play to see how your video is looking.

8. Go to the **Home** menu and click the **Add title** button.



Enter the title of your movie and jazz it up a bit with **fonts**, **colour**, **background colour** and **effects**.

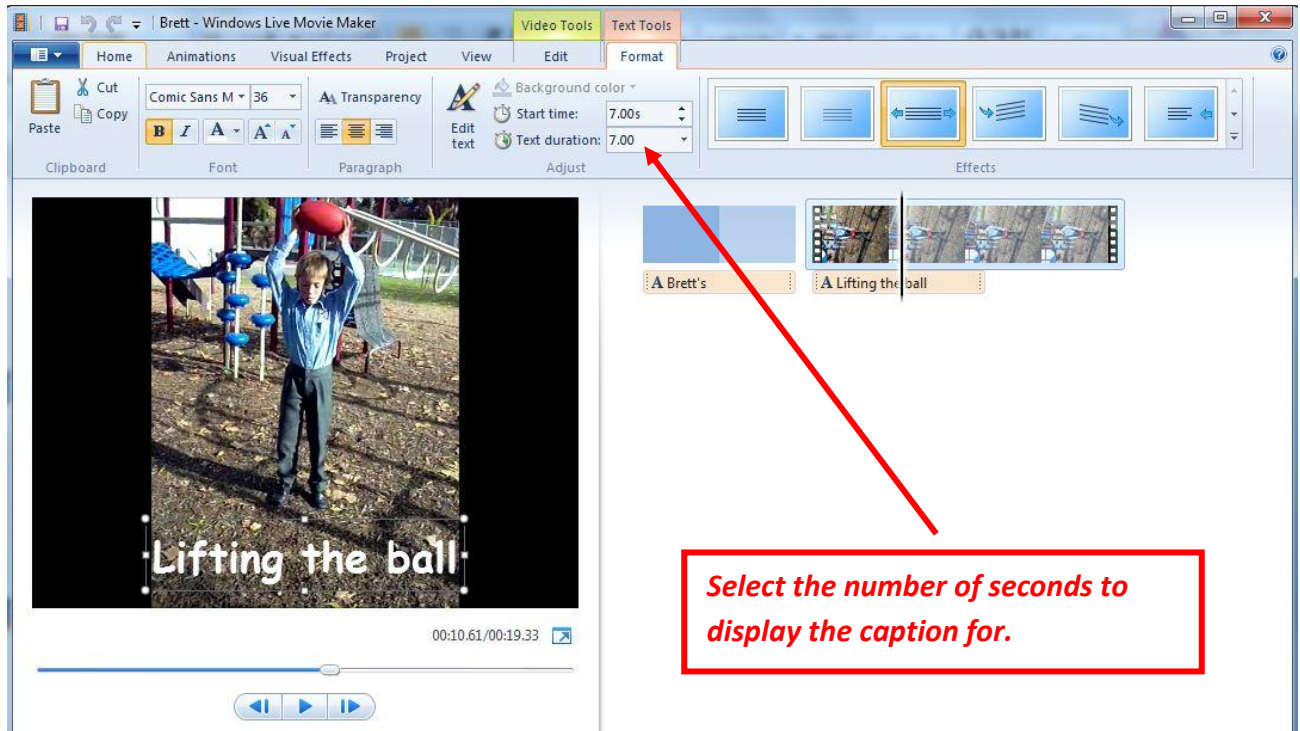


Select the number of seconds to display the title for.

9. Go to the **Home** menu and click the **Add caption** button.

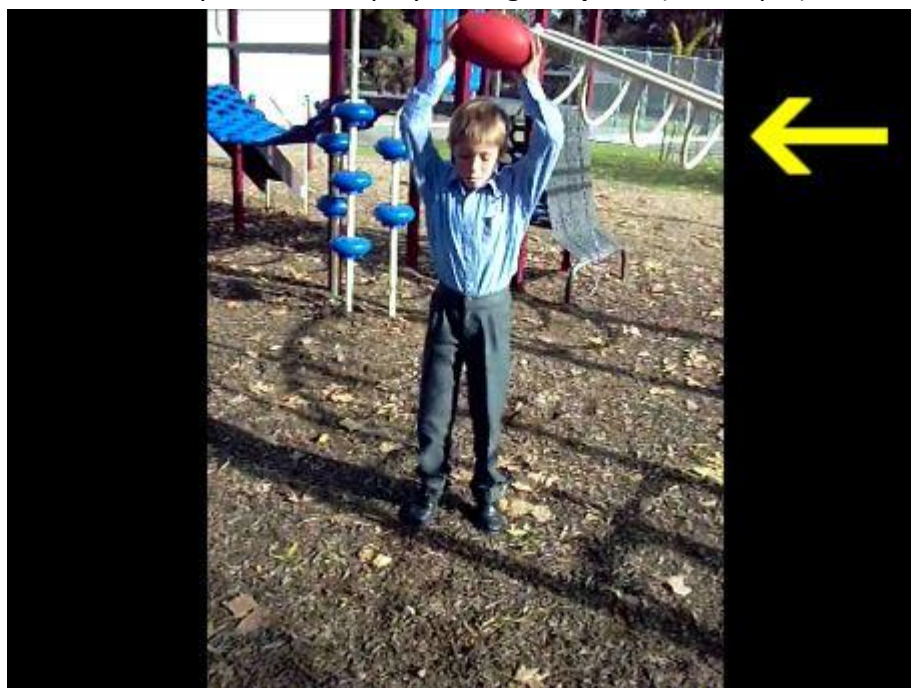


Enter one or more captions to your video clip and jazz them up a bit with **fonts, colour, background colour and effects**.



Select the number of seconds to display the caption for.

10. Add **arrows** to your video clip by adding a **caption** (see step 8) and editing it as follows.



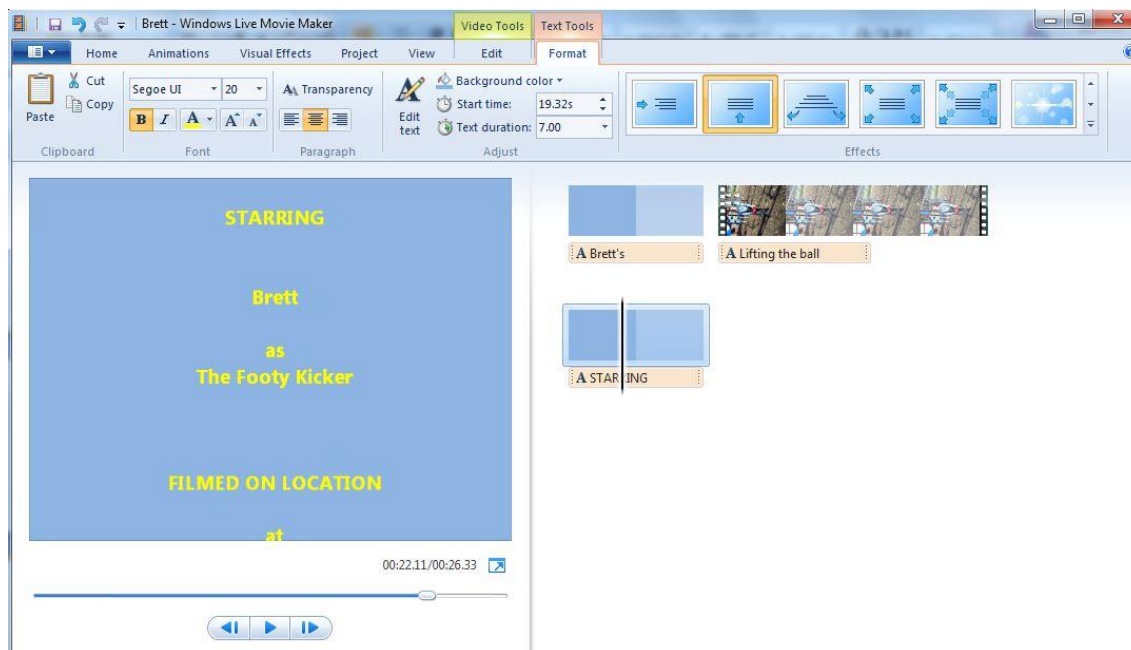
*Select the **Wingdings 3** font and then type one of the following letters :*

*f – left arrow
g – right arrow
h – up arrow
i – down arrow
j – left, up arrow
k – right, up arrow
l – left, down arrow
m – right, down arrow*

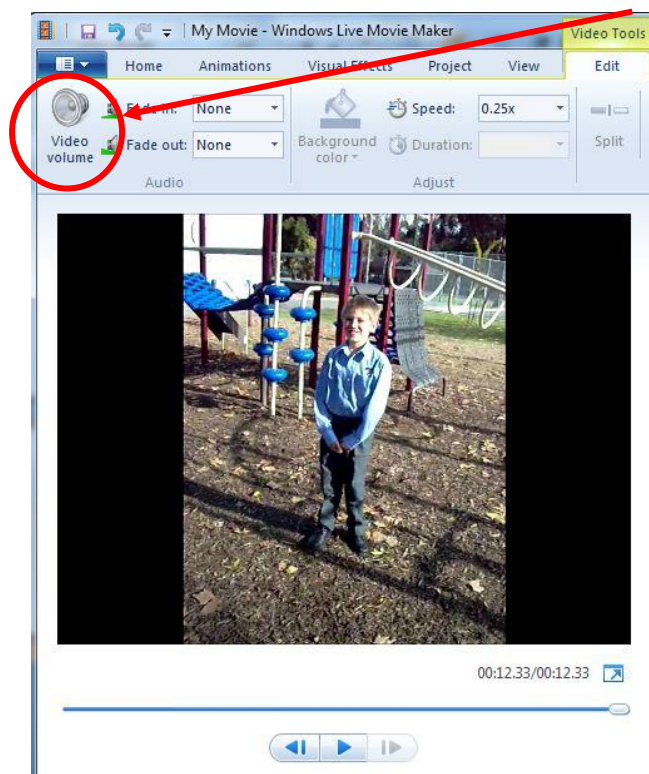
11. Go to the **Home** menu and click the **Add credits** button.



Type in the credits for your movie clip and jazz it up a bit with **fonts, colour, background colour** and **effects**.



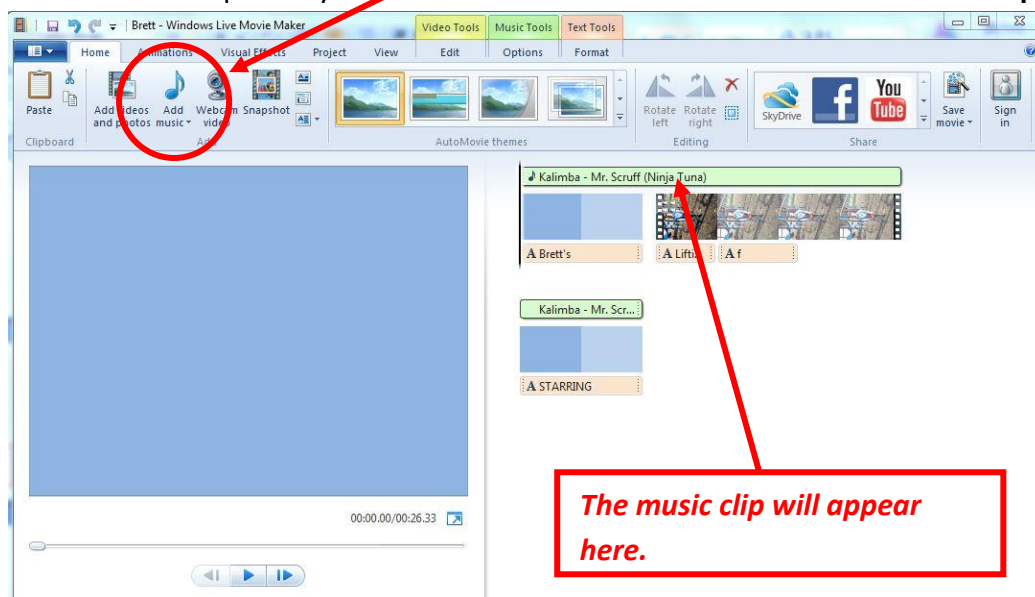
12. Go to the **Video Tools Edit** menu and select **Video volume**.



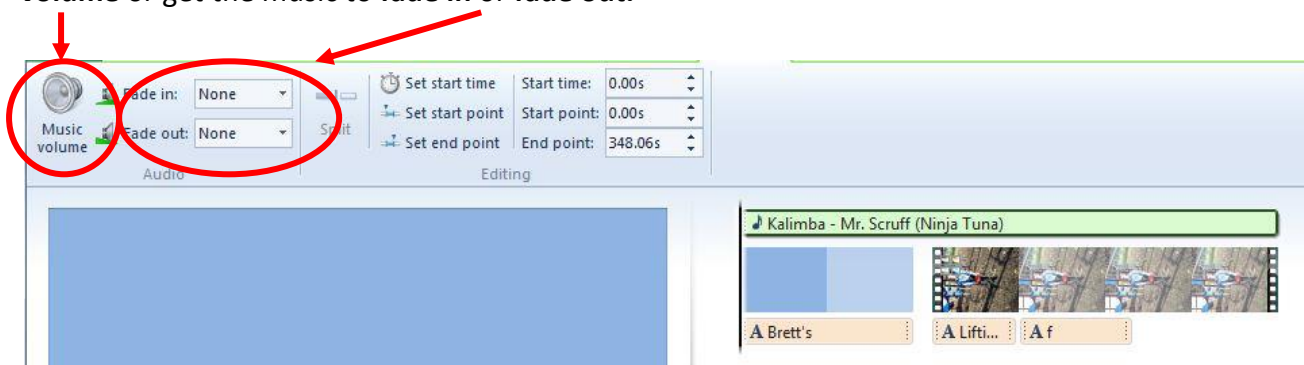
Slide the volume control all the way to the left so that the video is silent.

13. Go to the **Home** menu and select **Add music**.

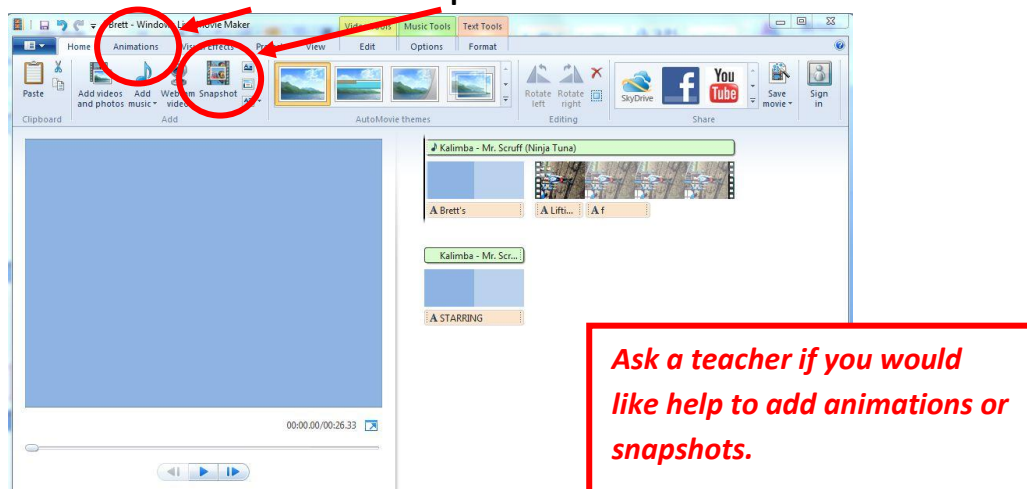
Select a music clip from your USB drive or the school network and then click **Open**.



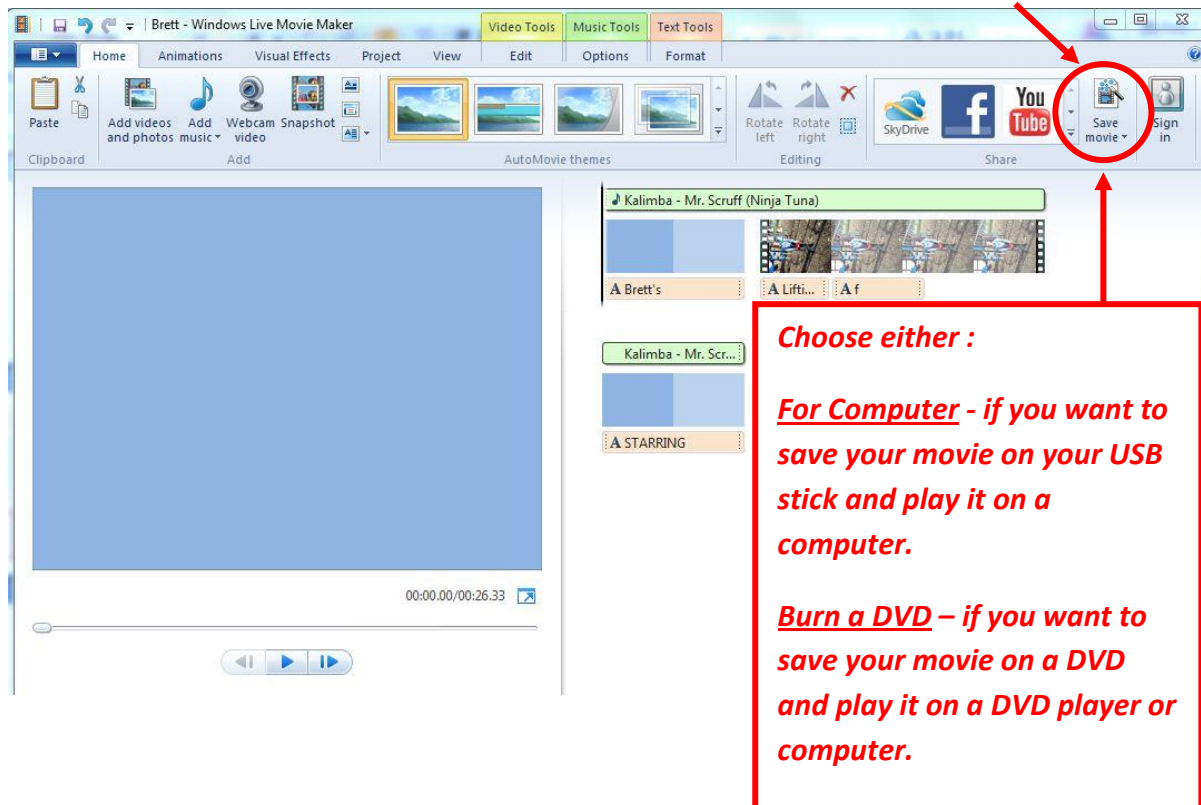
Double-click on the music clip or select **Music Tools** if you want to change the **volume** or get the music to **fade in** or **fade out**.



14. You are now ready to **play** your movie and make any final changes to it. If you have time you might also like to add **Animations** or **Snapshots**.



15. When you are happy with your movie, go to the **Home** menu and select **Save movie**.



16. You can now play your movie and share it with other people. We hope that you enjoyed this activity and using Windows Live Movie Maker.

Remember to close Windows Live Movie Maker when you have finished and then log off of the computer.
